

SUMMER WATER USAGE CHECK-UP

Summer brings an increase in temperatures and water use and is a good time for a check-up on your irrigation systems. Mission Resource Conservation District (MCRD) offers a free no-obligation irrigation evaluation for commercial, residential, and agricultural properties with one or more acres of planted and irrigated land. Irrigation system evaluations are a valuable tool for managing water resources and can often lead to savings of 10 percent or more on your water consumption.

MCRD will schedule a site walk-through with one of their certified irrigation professionals, who will identify opportunities for water savings, site-specific recommendations, and an easy-to-understand report and recommendations for summer landscape preparations and water budgeting management. Please keep in mind, by June 30, 2021, all customers receiving the PSAWR program rate must be in one of these four eligibility programs:

- ◆ San Diego Growers List - Pesticide Use
- ◆ Active Certified Producers Certificate – County of San Diego Organic
- ◆ Producers - United States Department of Agriculture
- ◆ San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board General Agricultural Order Enrollment Program
