RE: Information to Developers regarding RMWD Drought Response Level 2

To Whom It May Concern:

Rainbow Municipal Water District (RMWD) declared a Drought Response Level 2 at its April 2009 Board Meeting. Information regarding the Drought Response Level 2 (DRL2) can be found in Ordinance 08-01, which can be requested from the District Office. The DRL2 may impact your future improvements. Those impacts include:


- The following will not be provided:
 - New potable water service
 - New temporary meters (construction meters)
 - Permanent meters
 - Statements of immediate ability to serve or provide potable water service (will serve letters, certificates, or letter of availability)
 - Annexations

- Exceptions to this restriction include:
 - A valid unexpired building permit was issued prior to the April Board Meeting
 - In the opinion of the Board the project is necessary to protect the public's health, safety and welfare, or
 - Water demands for the project will be offset to the satisfaction of RMWD

The length of this DRL2 event is unknown and is dependent on the rain, customer conservation, and the actions taken at the MWD and SDCWA.
