Board Agenda Policies

Board of Directors Meeting Schedule Regular Board meetings are normally scheduled for the 4th Tuesday of the month with Open Session discussions starting time certain at 1:00 p.m.

<u>Breaks</u> It is the intent of the Board to take a ten minute break every hour and one-half during the meeting.

<u>Public Input on Specific Agenda Items</u> Any person of the public desiring to speak shall fill out a "Speaker's Slip", encouraging them to state their name, though not mandatory. Such person shall be allowed to speak during public comment time and has the option of speaking once on any agenda item when it is being discussed. Speaking time shall generally be limited to three minutes, unless a longer period is permitted by the Board President.

Agenda Posting and Materials Agendas for all regular Board of Directors' meetings are posted at least seventy-two hours prior to the meeting on bulletin boards outside the entrance gate and the main entrance door of the District, 3707 Old Highway 395, Fallbrook, California 92028. The agendas and all background material may also be inspected at the District Office.

(There are several pressing issues currently under consideration at the SDCWA, and without a Rainbow representative our positions and concerns are not heard. Staff recommends the Board appoint a representative as soon as possible and approve Resolution No. 15-03, validating that appointment.)

*15. RESOLUTION NO. 15-04, DESIGNATING ANOTHER DISTRICT'S REPRESENTATIVE AS PROXY VOTE TO THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY IN THE ABSENCE OF THE RAINBOW MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVE. RESOLUTION NO. 15-04 RESCINDS RESOLUTION NO. 12-13.

(In the event Rainbow Municipal Water District's representative is unable to attend a San Diego County Water Authority meeting, the named representative will be designated as proxy vote. In the past Gary Arant of Valley Center Municipal Water District has been named as RMWD's proxy.)
(Staff recommends adoption of Resolution No. 14-04 with the named proxy and RMWD representative

respectively.
